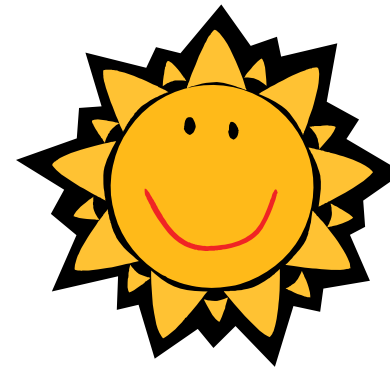

We are very excited for Summer Splash 2008! After reading parent surveys, interviewing teachers, and studying other summer programs Summer Splash as made some positive changes to enhance your children's summer learning experience. Make sure to check out our mission statement on the back of this brochure.

Summer Splash classes are now three hours. With this added time your children will have more hands-on activities, interactive experiences, as well as a short outdoor recess. The new schedule is: the morning session- 8:30-11:30am, lunch- 11:30-12:30, and the afternoon session- 12:30-3:30pm. Aftercare will be available from 3:30-4:30pm.

To simplify the registration process **each age group has their own colored brochure.** Preschool- Kindergarten is green, Grades 1-3 is blue, and Grades 4-6 is purple. We will be using these colors for each age group throughout Summer Splash for sign-in, nametags, etc.

If you register for Summer Splash before May 1st you will save! Classes are only \$70 for early registration, but if you wait to registrar the price is \$80 after May 1st.

This year we are focusing on sharing God's love. As part of each class students will join in a devotion and prayer time. We feel very privileged to teach your children about Jesus!

Grades 4-6

Summer Splash has three age levels for Summer 2008: Preschool-Kindergarten, Grades 1-3, and Grades 4-6. Choose the grade level your child will be entering in the fall.

All classes are 3 hours. There are two sessions daily, with a lunch in between for students staying for both sessions. The morning session is from 8:30-11:30am, lunch from 11:30-12:00pm, and the afternoon session from 12:30-3:30 each day. Lunch is included for students staying for both sessions, otherwise there is a \$4 fee/child. Aftercare is available from 3:30-4:30pm, for a \$4 fee/child.

We will not be offering a hot lunch program. Your child will need to bring a cold lunch and a drink if he/she is staying for lunch. Refrigerators and microwaves will NOT be available.

There is a \$70 nonrefundable fee due at the time of registration. The registration fee will be applied to the cost of the class. The payment for each session is due by noon on the first day of the camp.

You may register in person at the school office, by FAX, by e-mail, or mail. Forms will be processed in the order they are received. If forms are faxed or e-mailed, the registration fee is due in one week.

Class sizes will vary between 8 and 20. We will cancel a class that has less than 8 children registered. If a class is full when we receive your registration form, you will be contacted to pick another class.

Confirmation will be sent by mail after registration forms are processed.

Morning Session (8:30-11:30am)

Tour de West County: Bring your bike and join Mr. Peregoy at a different park each day to bike! Students will be driven to a park and will bike from there. This class will go until 12pm each day.

Watercolors: This is for the artist! Study water color paintings and learn to create your own masterpieces.

Afternoon Session (12:30-3:30pm)

Scrapbooking, Stamps, Etc.: Bring your ideas, pictures, and memories as you create a scrapbook, cards, bookmarks, and other fabulous crafts!

Morning Session (8:30-11:30am)

Rainforest Adventures: Explore the rainforest and discover amazing plants and animals! Hands-on lessons, group projects, exploration and more will all be part of the adventure!

3D Media Mix: Learn about design and structure as you use a variety of materials (such as wood, metal, plastic, and clay) to create 3D pieces.

Afternoon Session (12:30-3:30pm)

Creative Writing: Sharpen your pencils for a great class that works on your creative writing skills! Practice different writing techniques as you work to publish your own piece.

Body Works: God created our bodies, each unique and amazing! Study the human body through experiments, hands-on demonstrations, and more!

Week Three: July 7th- 11th, 2008

Morning Session (8:30-11:30am)

Science Splash: Let the world of science amaze you in this hands-on class! Explore the world we live in through fun experiments, observations, and more.

Story Creations: This class will combine your love of writing with great computer skills! Write your own story, and then use computer animation to bring it to life.

Afternoon Session (12:30-3:30pm)

Mind Masters: Build your strategy and problem solving skills as you master games, puzzles and problems from all areas of academia. Once you are a master you can create your puzzles!

Around the World: Collect stamps in your "passport" as you study cultures, cook new foods, and create masterpieces from around the world.

Week Four: July 14th- 18th, 2008

Morning Session (8:30-11:30am)

Creative Cooks: Combine one part creativity, one cup cooking skills, and one cup knowledge, bake for 3 hours. The result is an amazing class where you will learn recipes you can make at home.

Volleyball: Bump, Set, Spike! Practice your volleyball skills in an environment where teamwork and good sportsmanship is emphasized.
